***Luke 9:21-27 NLT Jesus warned His disciples not to tell anyone who He was.<sup>22</sup> “The Son of Man must suffer many terrible things,” He said. “He will be rejected by the elders, the leading priests, and the teachers of religious law. He will be killed, but on the third day He will be raised from the dead.”<sup>23</sup> Then He said to the crowd, “If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross daily, and follow me.<sup>24</sup> If you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it.
