To begin, I need all forms from your packet turned in at open house or on your child's first day. If you do not have, and cannot get, a completed physical form by the first day please contact me at 337-0442.

We require all payments be accompanied by a payment receipt form. You will receive a booklet at open house, or on your child's first day. It is helpful that these be used all year. These forms are turned in monthly as verification of payment. Your first payment is due September 1, if you have not received a booklet please contact me.

All tuition is due on the first of each month. Please place payment receipt form and check/cash into an envelope (this can be an old junk mail envelope, a Ziploc bag, etc.) and put in the large pocket of your child's book bag. This is the only pocket that will be checked daily. If you have extenuating circumstances please contact me to make arrangements. All conversations will be confidential. If you find yourself in a financial situation please, please contact me before removing your child. Our goal is to work with you and do our best to keep your child in school, please allow us to help.
